

This home learning is for the Christmas period. Try to do as many activities as you can. You can try each activity more than once. This will help your child learn and remember new skills.

Activity 1

Use the recipe below to make playdough with your child. Once ready, you and your child can have fun playing together. You use your hands to make models or add tools such as table knives and forks.

Uncooked Playdough Recipe

Ingredients:

8 tbsp plain flour

2 tbsp table salt

60ml warm water

1 tbsp vegetable oil

Method:

1. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl.
2. Add in the water and the oil and mix together.
3. Place the dough on a floured surface and Knead together for a few minutes to form a smooth dough.



Activity 2

Our topic for Spring 1 is called 'What is the best way to get there?' Take your child on different types of public transport such as the tube or bus.

Talk to your child about where you are going and how you will pay for the journey. Talk about all the things you see and do on your journey.



Activity 3

Practise counting with your child every day. You can count anything!

Make collections of objects for you and your child to count together. Show your child how you would count. Let your child decide how they will count. You can make different collections of objects to count. Start with 5-10 objects.
