

# Nursery- helping your child with Communication and Language

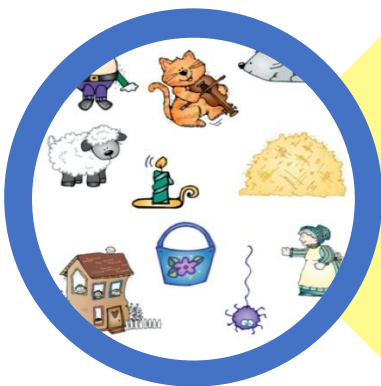


## Phonics

With your child, use your voices to create some familiar sound effects such as a ticking clock or a doorbell. Listen to the sounds around your home - encourage your child to make sounds just like them!

## Role Play

Set up a 'shop' at home, gather items from around your home to sell, such as small toys, food or even cutlery. Encourage your child to invite different family members to come and 'buy' items from your shop.
