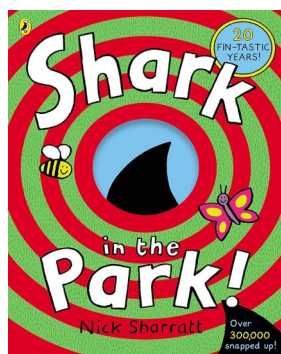


This week, we have been learning:

Maths

- Use different objects that you have at home to represent numbers to 20.
