# Reception - helping your child with Communication and Language



## Play '20 questions.'

Step 1: Think of an object (or an animal)

Step 2: The other players ask a Yes or No questions until

the object is discovered.

Step 3: Let the winner choose the next mystery object.

Here are some example questions: Would you find in at home? Does it have four legs? Is it smaller than me?

## Role Play

Pretend you are all firefighters, doctors or police officers. Create scenarios to act out with your child. There could be a fire on the sofa; a sibling has hit their head and needs medical care from your little doctor or a burglar in the house that need arresting and taken to jail. The possibilities are endless!
