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# WHAT IS TRANSITION?

- Transition is like getting ready
- Think about going for a new job and all the things you do beforehand to get ready for it .



# NURSERY TO RECEPTION AND EYFS

- All children will have transition into their classes.
- There will be an open day/evening at school where you can get some information about the phase your child will be having .
- We have a short transition session into the setting.
- We may visit children in their setting.
- Some children may need further support with this and staff will work closely with you.



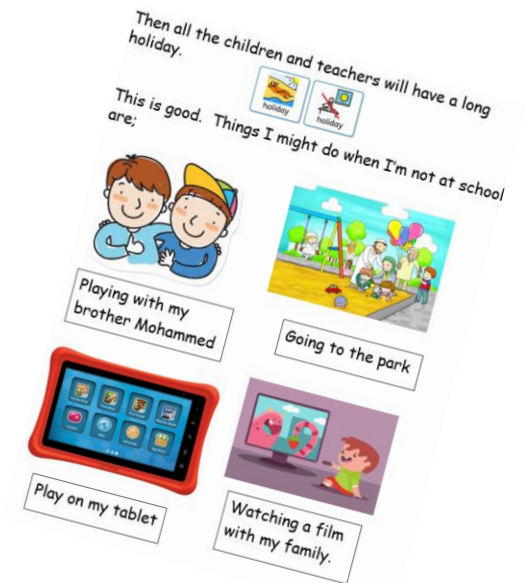
# HOW YOU CAN SUPPORT.

- Talk to your child
- Share the transition booklet made by the school.
- Over the summer break walk to the school- look through the gates .
- Get uniform ready and allow the child to wear it .
- Have lunch from the packed lunch .

# FROM CLASS TO CLASS

- All children will meet their new teacher and class.
- Some children will have a transition booklet made with them .
- Some children may have additional transition visits to see their teacher and visit the class

The teachers will meet and handover information from class to another about the children .



# TOP TIPS

- Make sure you have uniform ready before you begin school again
- Talk to your child about any worries.
- Remember they will still see their friends and some of their previous teachers.



# PRIMARY TO SECONDARY

- Secondary schools usually invite the new Year 7 cohort to the school before the other children join.
- Speak to your child about how they will get to school and also practice this with them.
- You and the child may naturally feel worried .
