<u>Supporting deaf parent – To all deaf parents</u> <u>Deaf Parents support group monthly</u>

BPCF received a small pot of money to host a support group for deaf parents who have a child with SEND , who are either deaf themselves or hearing with additional needs such as ASD . This group of parents meet monthly on Mondays with access to a interpreter to receive information about services in Brent and to share experiences of accessing council services, attending A and E visiting their GP , trying to gain support for their children with home work support , behaviour support and communicating with schools . This Group has been meeting now for 18 months and as a result we are very pleased to have made important changes all influenced by deaf parents.

We are supported by Brent Adult Education and Brent Inclusion service who fund a tutor and interpreter. We have seen the children attending make friends and develop their confidence and actually begin to enjoy home work!
