Activity 1

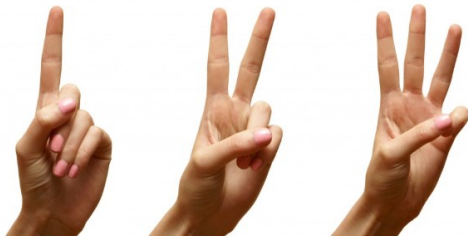
This week we have been reading Brown Bear Brown Bear. What do you see?
