

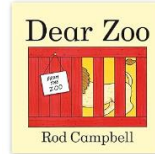

Listen to the story again. Encourage your child to join in with the repeated refrains e.g. I sent him back!



Questions to ask your child:

Why was the lion sent back?

Why was the frog sent back?

Why was the giraffe sent back?

Which pet would you keep?

Maths

Make collections of three objects with your child. You could use bowls, plates or baskets to hold each collection. Go around your home find three of each item e.g. spoons, coins or toys. Show your child how to count three items by pointing to each item and say a number name for each.



Communication

This twist on the classic game Simon says is great for younger children. All you need is their favourite toy.

You can introduce loads of new words to you child when you play this, from verbs to colours, numbers, body parts and loads more.
