Literacy

Maths



Ask your child to listen carefully. Choose an animal from the story and describe it. Ask your child if they can guess which animal you were describing. Example:

I am thinking of an animal. It has 4 legs, a tail and a very long neck. Which animal am I thinking of?

Repeat using other animals. Swap roles so your child gets to describe for you.

Draw pictures with your child to represent the number 2. You might draw two rabbits, two robots and two birds.

Physical Development

Play some music of your choice and dance with your child. Make up different movements and see if your child can copy them. Ask your child to make up some movements. Have fun dancing together.

Play a game with your child that involves taking turns. You will have to choose a game based on the resources you have at home. Ideas include:
