Dear Parents/Carers,

It was lovely to see lots of you at our Chit Chat morning on Friday 5th May.

Please find below the outcomes of the matters discussed at the meeting.

Things we do well at Lyon Park Primary:

- Reading Clubs are well delivered and children enjoy attending these.
- Children in Reception classes settle really well; the staff are very caring and supportive.
- Parents/Carers were very happy that the school was celebrating wider events such as the King's Coronation; this is important for our children and families.
- Children enjoy attending school; they always want to attend even when not feeling 100%.
- Children are talking about their learning at home with parents/carers. Parents/Carers are learning from children.
- Communication via text messages and emails are much better; really helpful.
- The school creates a sense of community for the children.

Things you felt we could develop:

- More Maths Clubs for children to attend; Ms Bhambra to send out a questionnaire to look at interests for clubs for the next academic year.
- Remind children to drink water throughout the day; staff to remind children of this.
- Disruption of strikes in April and May had been difficult for children with SEND; parents/carers understood the reason for the strikes. School are supporting children to minimise impact and resettle children.
- Some parents/carers asked if club payments could be broken down into instalments; Ms Bhambra to speak to the Office staff to discuss this.
- Can we offer Breakfast Club / extended after school care; Ms Bhambra to send a questionnaire out to identify an expression of interest.
- Can we provide a space for parents/carers to wait for children attending clubs when the weather is not great; there is a new Community space open on Beresford Avenue. Families can wait here free of charge.
- Information from the Welfare Team is sometimes difficult to understand. Can parents/carers receive support for this; a workshop to be arranged for parents/carers to attend. School will support with downloading the app and how to access the information.
- Sometimes there is miscommunication with teachers not knowing that children should be in a club; Ms Bhambra to speak with the office staff regarding communication with staff.
- Do we offer swimming lessons? Ms Bhambra to liaise with Mr Moran to share information of how to access these in the next newsletter.

Thank you to Mr Fenton who was able to join us for this month's meeting; Mr Fenton spoke about the rationale for teachers striking. He was interested to find out from parents/carers, ways in which we could generate additional income for school. This will be a standing agenda item at every Chit Chat Meeting.

Thank you once again for your attendance and input; we look forward to continuing to work in partnership with all our parents/carers to ensure the best outcomes for our children.
