RE: Relationships and Sex Education

Dear Parents/Carers,

At Lyon Park Primary School, we will cover both the statutory and non-statutory aspects of the framework of the National Curriculum for Science, RE and PSHE.

As a part of our PSHE curriculum, all children at Lyon Park School will be learning about the changes their bodies go through during puberty in the unit Changing Me. Year 4, 5 and 6 will be learning about the reproductive system as a part of this.

At Lyon Park we believe it is important to support pupils' ongoing emotional and physical development effectively. To prepare both boys and girls for the changes that adolescence brings and drawing on knowledge of the human life cycle set out in the National Curriculum for Science (how a baby is conceived and born). We will ensure that its teaching and materials are appropriate, having regard to the age and religious backgrounds of pupils including special educational needs or disabilities.

Parents/Carers have the right to withdraw their child(ren) from non-statutory/non-science components of sex education, which are listed below:

Year 4- Lesson 2- Having a Baby

Year 5- Lesson 4- Conception

Year 6 – Lesson 3- Babies- Conception to Birth

Alternative work will be given to pupils who are withdrawn from these lessons. All other lessons are statutory.
