Monday - Sports Day

Monday is the whole school sports day which Year 6 will be taking part in.

Tuesday – Inflatable Day

Morning sessions will be PE and Music. Children should wear their P.E. kit as there will be an inflatable assault course, foot dart game, bouncy castle and slide in the field. There will be ice lollies for the children in the afternoon.

Wednesday – Disco Day

Children can wear their own clothes (party clothes are encouraged) for their afternoon disco and party. Pizza and drinks will be provided. Children will not need to bring in a school lunch that day but can do if they wish. Children will be eating between 1-2pm. 6N will still go swimming in the morning and can change back into their party clothes.



Thursday – Gaming Day

Children should wear their school PE kit on this day. In the afternoon children will be able to enjoy music, funfair games and some fun sports in the field.

Friday – Cinema Day

We will be walking to Cineworld in Wembley Park for a 10am showing. Children are to arrive in school as normal. We will be back at school in time for a normal school lunch. Children should wear their normal school uniform. Children may also bring a bottle of water and snacks to enjoy during the movie (no nuts).

Cost

The total cost of the week will be £17 per child. This covers the cost of the cinema, pizza, drinks and equipment hire for all of the week's events. The school has worked with providers to ensure the best possible value for money.

A link will be sent to parents later today for payment via ParentPay. If you wish, you may pay the full amount of £17 in one payment or you can use the alternative payment plan available which is outlined below.

Payment Plan

- 1st Instalment of £6 – June 21st
- 2nd Instalment of £6 – June 28th
- Final instalment of £5 - July 5th

In cases of financial difficulties, you are invited to speak to a member of SLT. You can contact the office if you need support to make a payment. Please note that if insufficient contributions are received, then the visit will have to be cancelled and all monies will be returned.
